Congratulations on joining the Caravan and Motorhome Club and choosing to register with The Herts Centre.

### **NEW RALLIERS**

We are proud to have over 500 members of the Hertfordshire Centre but sadly, only approximately 10% of those actually attend our rallies. So let me tell you a little about what a centre rally is all about.

Firstly, look through the book and see what takes your fancy. If it's a quiet, sit back, relax and chill out sort of a weekend then choose one that is perhaps by a river or canal which is usually held over the summer period.

These rallies usually have quite a small number of units ranging from 10 -15 vans in attendance and are a great way to start out rallying, mainly because if the weather is good, people sit outside their vans and get chatting to each other.

Sometimes the rally officers (who are just ordinary ralliers volunteering to run the rally) may organize a small social activity such as a communal BBQ or an American supper in the evenings to bring people together. These socials are optional and you can choose to be included or not.

We are a friendly bunch of people and have members from young through into retirement age.

Also we hold many centre competitions throughout the year, for example boules, darts and fishing and some rallies are specifically held to include these events. These are usually run by rally officers who enjoy a bit more of an active weekend and are generally well attended by members.

These rallies may be a bit larger with perhaps 20 -25 units attending. For those of you that like having a good old boogie, we also hold what we call full on rallies, these are usually held in a school building where the rally site is on a school playground and hard standing. Some have electric on site and may be held over a longer period of time.

For example, our New Year Rally is held over 5 days; many others are held to include bank holidays. These rallies either include a disco which caters for all ages or a professional band may be hired to entertain us all. Generally, because schools have catering facilities a 2 or 3 course meal might be included at an additional cost; for example, this year's, Easter, Chairman's weekend, Christmas Party, New Year Rally and many others.

All sites charge us a site fee per van per night and this is the cost seen in the rally book for two nights stay or more. Any social activity that rally officers decide to arrange, such as a small meal will be added on as an extra payment - average cost of a small social fee is £5 per person, children are charged less, and often are free. Rallies that hire a disco or band, plus a 2/3 course meal, plus a school hall obviously needs to charge more and this will be added onto a pre-paid booking form. Whatever you choose I can guarantee you will receive a warm welcome from our members who regularly rally. My husband Alan and I will be attending many of the rallies in this book and will look forward to seeing you join us on the rally field, hopefully in the near future.

Information on booking a rally can be found in the book, keep looking on the website for regular rally updates as many rally officers send out additional information nearer the time of the rally.

So finally look through the book and see what takes your fancy. If you want to speak to someone first then feel free to phone the rally officer whose name appears for that rally, or alternatively please feel free to phone me or any of the committee members at the front of this book.

I hope this helps you to think about joining us on one of our rallies.


